
FOLLOW THE VALOR CONTEST WIDE OPEN WITH MONTH REMAINING STABLE'S 48 WINS IN 2011 HAVE 45 PARTNERS IN HUNT FOR FIRST PLACE HERRICKMAY BEINCATBIRD'S SEAT, UNLESS HIS OWN HORSE WINS G1

Team Valor International received 121 entries for its popular Follow the Valor contest that challenged partners to predict the stable's win total for 2011. With a month left in the season, 45 partners are within close range of the moving target.

The stable has collected 48 wins this year, which was the projection from nine partners. As a tiebreaker, the contest also called for a prediction of the annual stable earnings, which stand at \$3,923,779. At this point, John Kelly is dosest to the mark—he projected 48 wins and \$3,850,001 in earnings.

Fifteen entries pegged 49 wins, and Gerry Shaikun and Laurie Smith are the dosest from that group with an earnings prediction of \$3,985,000.

Assuming the Team Valor roster is good for a couple more wins by the end of the year, Norton Herrick may be in the best position of all—his forecast was 50 wins and \$3,875,000. Ironically, Herrick could be knocked out by his own horse if Lucky Chappy prevails in the \$750,000 CashCall Futurity on December 17.
